## **High School Physical Education (PE) and Computer Teacher**

### **Who are we?**

Founded in Switzerland in 1978, [Mercy Ships](#) is an international Christian humanitarian organization whose mission is to improve access to health care in developing countries in Africa.

### **Description of the position**

The Academy High School Physical Education (PE) and Computer Teacher works on board our hospital ship at the [Mercy Ships Academy](#), a school with 50 to 60 pupils, all children of the ship's crew. Students and staff come from various countries around the world.

The Academy Physical Education and Computer teacher develops and maintains an age-appropriate environment, instructs, and evaluates students in Physical Education: movement skills, fitness and health, and sports while providing proper communication with parents and school administration.

The teacher will be housed on the ship but will have the opportunity to explore and visit the host country during free time.

### **Education and experience required**

- A current teaching certificate (Bachelor's Degree in physical education or a related field)
- A minimum of 2 years classroom experience teaching is preferred
- Very good knowledge of English. Although several of our destinations are located in French-speaking countries, the common language spoken by the 400 crew members on board the ship is English.
- Successful completion of Mercy Ships Onboarding program (starting on June 11)
